- d. A one-page personal statement

- a. A current official transcript of your academic work, submitted in a sealed envelope
- b. A statement of enrollment
- c. A letter of recommendation from an instructor at the institution where you are currently enrolled. The recommendation must be written on official letterhead and be submitted in a sealed envelope.
- d. A one-page personal statement
